- Permit is only valid from April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, until the village roads are opened to regular traffic
- Approval is subject to compliance of AVS 799 bylaws, conditions and council approval
- Snowmobiles will not be given a permit
- Your ATV/UTV must be fully insured and displaying a licence plate
- Your ATV/UTV must have snow tracks intended for snow roads
- All drivers must have a valid driver's licence
- ATV/UTV usage may only be between 8am and 9pm
- Permit may be revoked at any time without notice

INSURANCE

- the applicant(s) must provide a copy of public liability insurance to the values of \$1 million
- the applicant(s) must indemnify council and AVS 799 membership from any loss or damage arising from personal injury or property loss suffered as a result of any village conditions or applicants' negligence

**SAFETY**

- the applicant(s) must ensure that their ATV/UTV is safe and in good working order
- the applicant must have as part of their ATV/UTV an elevated orange flag
- maximum speed is 15 km/hr
- helmets must be worn by driver and passengers of ATVs and UTVs, unless a UTV is equipped with seat belts and roll bars they are exempt from wearing helmets (seat belts must be worn)

**POLLUTION & NOISE**

- the applicant(s) ATV/UTV must have an appropriate muffler/noise reducing apparatus

**INSPECTIONS**

- The applicant(s) ATV/UTV must be inspected by a AVS 799 Council member and the Village Representative, before the permit can be obtained
- all deficiencies must be addressed before permits may be obtained
- Proof of Drivers licence(s) will be submitted

**ROAD CONDITIONS:**

- The applicant understands that the road conditions may change at any time without notice
- The applicant understands that the snow roads may deteriorate and leave voids under the snow
- The applicant understands that driving on the snow roads are at their own risk
